



COMMERCIAL RECYCLING SELF-SERVICE GUIDELINES

Businesses which deliver their recyclable items to the City of Johnson City Recycle Center must follow these guidelines. An attendant will be available to assist with disposal of recyclables.

Location: City of Johnson City Recycle Center
204 FM 2766 (road to Pedernales State Park)

Hours of Operation:

Monday through Friday: 8:00 am - 12:00 pm

Wednesday: 1:00 pm - 5:00 pm

Every first Saturday of the month: 9:00 am - 1:00 pm.

These materials are acceptable for recycling at the center:

- Cardboard and paperboard - broken down and flattened. *Boxes that are not broken down will be refused.*
- Newspaper, shredded paper, magazines and copy/printer paper.
- Aluminum and tin/steel cans. *Cans must be rinsed out and have no food residue.*
- White metals-washers/dryers, stoves/ovens, water heaters, microwaves, other major household appliances, yard equipment, water coolers, paper shredders, smoke detectors, loose batteries, wooden speakers, ceramic and glass lamps, crock pots, fire extinguishers (emptied) and exercise equipment. ***NOTE: Refrigerators and A/C Window Units are accepted ONLY with a label affixed stating that the Freon/coolant has been emptied.***

These materials **will not be accepted** for recycling:

- Plastic bottles and containers.
Please use the County recycling facility located at the Progressive Waste site on Hwy 281 (south of the city), open Monday through Friday, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm.
- Glass. Please use the County recycling facility for disposal described above.
- Tires.
- Hazardous waste materials.
- Styrofoam.
- Helium or propane tanks
- E-Waste

Do-It-Yourself Oil Center

The City of Johnson City also offers a free “Do-It-Yourself Oil Center” to properly dispose of used oil and filters.

Used oil must be placed in a secure container that may be emptied and reused for future recycling.

The Oil Center is accessible during the Center’s business hours.

Help us serve you better! Remember:

- ✓ Rinse all aluminum, tin or steel items to be recycled.
- ✓ Separate your recyclable material.
- ✓ Place items in the proper receptacle. Receptacles for each of the recyclables are easily identified for your convenience. Placing the right items in the specified carts keeps your Center neat, clean and working efficiently.
- ✓ Do not leave any materials outside the facility by the fence or on the grounds inside the fence.
- ✓ Do not dump garbage or household trash at the Recycle Center. Dumping is **illegal**. Violators will be subject to fines.
